
# POWER WORDS TO REMEMBER






#### Compare\*

Point out <u>similarities</u>, to examine 2 or more objects and consider the <u>likenesses</u>.

\* If used <u>without</u> CONTRAST, it can mean <u>both</u> similarities AND differences.





#### Contrast Point out differences; to examine 2 or more objects and consider the differences

#### Explain Tell how to do, give the meaning of, or why, give reasons for



#### Describe To give a picture or characteristics of something in words



#### Discuss

#### To give information about something in writing from various points of view




# Define Give a meaning for a word or phrase



#### Effect\*

#### A result or a consequence that can be positive or negative

\*EFFECT IS COMMONLY USED AS A NOUN; AFFECT IS COMMONLY USED AS A VERB.





#### Analyze

To study something closely and carefully, especially information; to learn the relationship of the parts



#### Summarize Tell the main idea; tell the beginning, middle, and end



# Support Back it up or prove your answer with details



#### Provide

To make available for use or consideration; to supply something that is useful or necessary



#### Evaluate

To judge the condition of something in a careful & thoughtful

way

(Tell the good and the bad.)



#### Differentiate\* To see or state the differences between two or more things

• **DISTINGUISH** means the same thing.



#### Predict To say that something will or might happen in the future



#### Perform l'o carry out, accomplish, or complete a task or action



#### Justify

To give good reasons for; defend; prove or show something to be right or reasonable



#### Claim

A statement that is open to challenge; an answer to a question



### Evidence Available body of facts

or <u>information</u> that indicates whether a statement is true or valid



#### Pose

## To <u>present</u> a problem; <u>ask</u> or <u>suggest</u> a question for



#### Interpret

To <u>explain</u> or provide the <u>meaning</u> of something; understand something in a <u>clear</u> or <u>precise</u> way



#### Propose

# To <u>suggest</u> an <u>idea</u> or <u>plan</u> for consideration or discussion by others

attention to
